



## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF SALE

### REGISTRATION

Your registration will be validated upon receipt of your registration form accompanied by your deposit payment.

### PAYMENT

Registration and payment terms:

The registration form and payment terms will be sent to you by email.

- Deposit of 40% of the total amount upon registration or 90 days before departure.
- The total balance 30 days before departure.

Failure to pay after these dates will be considered a cancellation on your part.

### CANCELATION

In the event of cancellation by you less than 30 days before departure, the deposits paid remain forfeited.

In the event of cancellation on our part, you will have the choice between another stay or a full refund of the amounts advanced.

For cruises and only in this case, in the event of a technical problem immobilizing the boat for more than two consecutive days, compensation will be provided corresponding to fifty percent of the daily rate and one hundred percent of the daily rate after two days if this permanently compromises the rest of your cruise, forcing you to leave the ship.

### PARTICIPATION

Participation in a stay on board implies your agreement regarding our conditions of sale listed above as well as your subscription to INDIVIDUAL INSURANCE (ASSISTANCE, REPATRIATION, ACCIDENT, ILLNESS), which you can take out with the company of your choice, knowing that many companies offer this type of insurance and repatriation packages.

## INSURANCE

The boat only has "Civil Liability" insurance.

This implies that under no circumstances can the skipper or the association be held responsible in the event of accident, illness or repatriation during the duration of the stay, whether on board, or during shore excursions.

Each team member must ensure that he or she meets the conditions of access to a country (valid passport and possible visa).

Neither the skipper nor the association can be held responsible in the event of a ban on one or more crew members entering a country.

The skipper is the only judge of the course. Neither he nor the association can be held responsible in the event of delays due to air connections, administrative contingencies, weather conditions or technical problems.

As far as flights are concerned, and in particular, the return flight, it is strongly recommended that our crew members take a "refundable and/or exchangeable cancellation" option, in case we are stranded outside the original port of disembarkation for weather or technical reasons.

In the event that you miss the return flight, neither the association, nor the captain, nor the chartered boat can be held responsible for this situation and this cannot give rise to any compensation or compensation. Additional transport costs (change of plane ticket, train tickets, car rental, taxi, etc.) will be at your expense.

Similarly, in the event of a delay in our return to the port of disembarkation due to weather or other reasons, it is strongly advised not to plan any significant commitments immediately after the date of return to your country of origin.

## MEDICAL

Be sure to take your medication for any treatment that concerns you as well as for possible seasickness. The boat has a first-aid kit on board and several useful things, but it is still basic.

## ASSOCIATION

The association "**Concept Voile Nature et Aventure Océanique**" to which the boat is attached aims to make you discover:

– Exceptional places of incomparable beauty

- A match between man and nature
- Clean energies (photovoltaic, wind, etc.)
- A hedonistic and epicurean philosophy where the pleasure of the senses will be your priority

The boat is chartered by the association for a non-profit purpose. You can join the boat for local cruises along the coasts of the country (or countries) where the boat is located, make a commitment for one or more weeks a year or embark on major ocean crossings.

To ensure that your stay remains forever an exceptional memory, we will ask you to participate in life on board. You will not be mere passengers, but the actors of your own dream. We do not ask for any particular nautical experience. You can be a beginner and this will be your initiation, or much more seasoned, and thus confirm your knowledge. Sailing does not require any particular physical qualities, but requires an open mind, tolerance and good manners that will make life on a sailboat easier.

You will be a team member in your own right. You will participate in the manoeuvres of the boat and in the life on board. This includes household chores (meals, dishes, cleaning, etc. from which the captain is exempt) and good humor!

If you choose to be accompanied by a hostess, you will just have to put your feet under the table. Please contact us well in advance in this case.
